A FEW FACTS ABOUT GAUDENZIA'S SERVICES IN LANCASTER, PENNSYLVANIA:

- We currently operate four programs that offer services for women, children and families.
- Our residential facility, Vantage, served over 50 children last year.
- In addition to being one of the first long-term residential treatment facilities for drug and alcohol addicted women and their children in the nation, Vantage is the only facility of its kind in Lancaster County and has become the national model for training purposes.
- The Bair-O'Malley House is independent housing for women and children that is recovery-oriented. These apartments are owned and operated by Gaudenzia.
- The Elsie Shenk Outpatient Center serves women in Lancaster County who are meeting the challenge of drug and alcohol addiction on an outpatient and intensive outpatient basis. Prevention services for children aged 3-12 are also provided onsite. This program serves approximately 180 women and children annually.
- Family Alternatives is operated by Gaudenzia in conjunction with Lancaster County Children and Youth Services to provide intensive case management to families as they work to gain stability in their lives.
- Our programs treat entire families holistically, through a continuum of services offered locally in Lancaster.

ABOUT GAUDENZIA:

In 1968 in Philadelphia, a group of business, political, and community leaders as well as people in recovery from drug and alcohol use recognized a serious problem: a growing number of people affected by addiction were unable to find help. Gaudenzia was founded to help meet this need. Since then, it is estimated that Gaudenzia has admitted into treatment over 200,000 individuals.

Gaudenzia began as a single facility. Today we operate 151 programs at 80 facilities throughout Pennsylvania, Maryland and Delaware. Now serving about 20,000 individuals annually, Gaudenzia operates residential and outpatient treatment programs, including specialty programs for pregnant and parenting women, individuals with HIV/AIDS, people coping with mental illness in addition to substance abuse issues, adolescents and more.

Gaudenzia continues to improve and expand our services, helping individuals and their loved ones overcome the ravages of addiction to drugs and alcohol.
